



1 Slightly Trim and file nails.

**Tips**

Clean the dust and oil completely. Use a nail prep dehydrator for best adhesion.



2 Apply Base Gel and cure under UV/LED lamp for 60-120s.

**Tips**

It's normal for the Base Gel to remain sticky. DO NOT WIPE. It would help the color gel adhere to fingernails better.



3 Apply a thin layer each time. Cure for 60-120s, 2-3 coats would cover well.

**Tips**

It is normal for the gel to feel sticky after curing. It will be sealed in with Top Coat.



4 Apply No Wipe Top Coat and cure under UV/LED lamp for 60-120s.

**Tips**

Seal the edges of your nails with the brush horizontally to avoid clipping and peeling off.

## How to make nails long-lasting results?

- 1: Prep works are essential for long-lasting nail art.
- 2: Please apply the foundational gel. Base Gel can protect your nails from pigmentation. Top Coat makes nail art brighter and lasts longer.
- 3: You can scrape off the excess gel on the mouth of the bottle before applying. Apply a thin coat of gel polish.
- 4: If the gel is exceeded to the skin or cuticle, please clean it before curing.
- 5: Cap the nail-free edge for each layer.
