Color Diffusing Sheets are a unique way to bring a vivid blend of color to new and exciting art projects! Roylco's **Color Diffusing Sheets** are made from a unique fabric texture that "grabs" colors and blends them into a rainbow of fun!

Tools that work great with **Color Diffusing Sheets** are: water mister, water-based paint, markers, food coloring, fruit juice concentrate, paint brushes, **R5519 Plastic Painting Bowls**, **R5451 Paint Scrapers**, **R5449 Paint Pipettes** and **R5516 Dip & Print Sponges**.

Painting Techniques:

Hint: **Color Diffusing Sheets** work even better when slightly damp.

Water-based markers and paints are best for color blending. Other kinds of paint or markers may blend a little, but are more likely to keep their original form.

Blend food coloring with water and watch the color separate and mingle throughout the design.

Color with washable markers. Mist lightly with a water bottle and watch a rainbow appear!

Use stencils or **R5845 Unruly Rulers** and washable markers to create a colorful neighborhood of shapes and images!

Mix permanent images with a burst of color! First draw your outlines with a colored pencil or crayon. Then color in around the outlines with washable markers. Mist with a water sprayer and watch as the colors blend and spread while leaving your outlines intact!

When you mist your paper, make sure to mist it only lightly. The blend of colors is slow at first and then gradually moves out. Use more water if you want a softer more pastel look.

To create a "tie-dyed" look, leave white spaces between each color before lightly misting with water.

Allow each project several hours to dry before displaying.
