

Button Definition

- 1. ⇒ button: Return to previous menu
- 2. ►II/ button: Select and enter different modes/Play/Pause/Power On/Off (press and hold)
- 3. NEXT button: Press to skip to the next file; press and hold to fast forward, move right in menu options
- PREVIOUS button: Press to skip to previous file; press and hold to fast rewind, move left in menu options
- 5. VOL+ button: Increase volume
- 6. VOL- button: Decrease volume

Battery Level Indicator

- Battery is full.
- ☐ Low battery; the player should be charged as soon as possible.

Important: Charge the player for at least 8 hours before using it for the first time.

Basic Operation

To turn the player off, press and hold the ► button until the display shuts off.

Note: "Press and hold" means long press for approx. 2 seconds.

Music Playback Controls

- PREVIOUS button: Previous track / Rewind (press and hold)
- NEXT button: Next track /Fast forward (press and hold)
- 3. ▶II/७ button: Enter music playback submenu, Play / Pause
- 4.

 button: Return to last viewed menu
- 5. **VOL+** button: Increase volume

Music Playback Submenu

Press and hold the ▶॥/७ button in the Music menu to enter the Music Playback Submenu as below:

In music PAUSE or PLAYBACK mode, press and hold the 5 button to access **Music Menu 2** to select the following options:

Video

To watch movies, select **Video** from the main menu and press the ► button to confirm. The video playback screen will be displayed.

- 3. ►11/0 button: Play/Pause

Movie Submenu

In this submenu, press the ► button to start the movie.

While a video is PAUSED, hold the 5 button to access the Video menu where you can select the following options:

Repeat: Video repeat options

Delete file: Delete a single video file

Delete all: Delete all video files

Pictures

To view pictures, select **Pictures** from the main menu and press the ▶ 11/0 button to enter the photo browser.

- 1. Use the **PREVIOUS** or **NEXT** button to scroll through the **ROOT** folder and select a photo you would like to view, then press the ▶ / ७ button.
- 2. Use the **PREVIOUS** or **NEXT** button to scroll through your pictures.
- 3. Press the 5 button to return to the **ROOT** folder.

Photo Menu

In the **ROOT** folder, press and hold the 5 button to access the Pictures menu where you can select the following options.

Brightness: Adjust brightness

Slideshow settings: Adjust playback method

Delete picture
Update playlist

Recordings

To record voice memos, select **Recordings** from the main menu and press the ► button to enter recording mode.

1. Press the ▶॥/७ button to start recording.

- 2. To pause the recording, press the ▶ 11/₺ button again.
- 3. To save the recording and exit to the main menu, press the → button.
- 4. If "Capacity is full" is shown on the display, it means that there is no space for saving the recorded files, and you need to delete other documents to free space.
- 5. If "Content is full" is shown on the display, it means that there are 99 files in this folder, please change to a different folder for saving.

Play

To play back recorded voice memos, select **Recordings library** from the main menu and press the ▶ | / ७ button to enter the voice memos mode.

Voice Playback Controls

- 2. **NEXT** button: Next memo /Fast forward (press and hold)

- 3. ▶ II/ ७ button: Play or pause recording
- 4. ★ button: Return to previous menu /Save recording (press and hold)
- 5. **VOL+** button: Increase volume
- 6. VOL- button: Decrease volume

Folder view

Press the **I**/o button to open **Folder**, where you can find all files in the folder.

E-book

The E-book mode allows reading text files. To use this mode, please follow below instructions:

- 1. Use the **PREVIOUS** or **NEXT** button to scroll through the **ROOT** folder and select a text you would like to read, then press the ▶ II / ७ button to confirm.
- 2. Use the **PREVIOUS** or **NEXT** button to scroll through your texts.
- 3. Press the 5 button to return to the **ROOT** folder.

In the **ROOT** folder, press and hold the so button to access the **E-book** menu where you can select the following options.

- Bluetooth off

Select **Bluetooth open**, the icon * will appear on the player, and then select "Select for device". Turn on the Bluetooth device you want to connect with, the player will show the Bluetooth device name and then connect. After being connected, the Bluetooth device will playback the songs which the MP4 player plays.
