Congratulations on purchasing a GingerSnap Neon Light. Used as per these instructions, your light should give you many years of enjoyment. However, it is a fragile glass structure and care should be exercised to not break the neon tube.

## Assembly

Assembly of your lamp is simple, but care is required to not damage the neon tube. Carefully remove the 3 components (neon tube, base unit and transformer) from the foam.

To insert the neon tube into the wooden base. Align the side of the neon tube plastic end with a clip (Fig. I) to the slot in the base section (Fig. 2). Insert the two metal pins in the base of the tube into the socket in the base unit. Press on the plastic fitting on the end of the neon tube (do NOT grasp the tube by the glass as this risks breaking the delicate tubes) to locate firmly into the base unit, as indicated by the arrow below (Fig. 3)





Locate your new neon light where you want it to be placed. Insert the transformer plug into the base unit and plug into a suitable electrical outlet. The Neon should now illuminate. Do not move the lamp whilst lit.
