

Quick guide

How can I set the language?

Travis supports the two-way translation of most languages. You can select the source language and target language as required on the screen for two-way translation*.



On the main screen of translation, touch a national flag icon to select the corresponding language



How can I start the translation?

After setting the languages, you can press the translation button to start translation. The " \square " button corresponds to the voice input in language as indicated on the left side of the screen, and the " \bigcirc " button to that on the right side.



Two-way translation: Not all pairs of languages support two-way translation.

List of available target languages: The number of supported languages varies. Online translation supports more than offline translation.

How can I use the magic button?


The " = " button between the two translation buttons is the magic button. You can press this button to select the language via voice command.



- Step 1 Press the magic button.
- Step 2 Speak "Select 'language 1' to 'language 2". (Language 1 and language 2 correspond the language on the left/right side of the screen respectively.)

NOTE

Currently, the voice command in Chinese, English, Spanish, Japanese, Korean, French, German, Russian, Arabic are supported. Voice command in other languages and more features will be launched soon.



On the main screen, you can touch" 🏶 " or swipe left to access the settings page where you can set the Wi-Fi, cellular data, hot spot and other features.

Important Battery Information

Battery: Do not attempt to replace the built-in battery yourself, you may damage the battery, which could cause overheating and injury.

Charging: Charging the device with the included USB cable and power adaptor.

Safety and Handling Information
