#### POLE CARE AND SYSTEM MAINTENANCE

The life of your basketball system depends on many variables. The climate, exposure to corrosives such as salt, pesticides or herbicides, and excessive use or misuse can all contribute to pole failure, which may cause property damage and/or personal injury.

Check your basketball system frequently for loose hardware, excessive wear, and signs of corrosion. For safety reasons, and to prolong the life of your basketball system, you must take the following preventative measures.

- 1. Check all nuts and bolts. If any are loose, tighten them.
- 2. Check all parts for excessive wear and tear. If necessary, replace any parts that have been worn or damaged through usage. Contact our Customer Service Department for replacement parts.
- 3. Inspect the warning stocker on the pole. If it is ripped, faded, or illegible, call our Customer Service Department to request a replacement sticker.
- 4. Check all pole sections for visible rust or chipped or cracked paint. If either is present, do the following:
  - a) Use an emery cloth to completely remove any rust or chipped paint.
  - b) Clean the area with a damp cloth and allow it to dry.
- c) Apply two coats of a rust preventative, high gloss enamel paint to the area. Allow the paint to dry between coats.





#### **GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**


- \* Do not hang from the goal or climb on the pole.
- \* Do not climb on the base or structure in general as this could result in serious personal injuries.
- \* Adjustments and moving of the basketball set must be carried out by adults.
- \* Always check the unit to ensure that the moulded base is full of water or sand, and all fittings and hardware are tight before each use.
- \* Always place the base on a flat surface.
- \* Do not let water freeze in the base.
- \*Two people are required for assembly.
- \*Keep the manual for future reference

\*Check over unit to make sure all hardware is tightly adequately.


\*Ensure the base is fully filled with either 115KG of Sand or 105KG of Water. \*Wrap pole cover #30.

OF THIS SYSTEM.

THE SYSTEM MUST BE REMOVED AND ASSEMBLED ONLY BY ADULTS WHO CAN SAFELY HANDLE THE WEIGHT.

- 1. Before assembling the system, the assembler must read all instructions carefully and ensure that all parts are present.
- 2. Before building the basketball system, you will need to choose a flat piece of ground void of any obstacles that could cause harm to the players.
- 3. Before using the system, the players must first check the stability of the base. The ground under the base should be free of sharp objects that could cause the base to leak. The base should be filled with the appropriate amount of sand or water, as outlined in the instruction manual.
- 4. Do not push or drag the base on the ground, as it may cause damage.
- 5. This system should not be used for a formal match. Dunking and hanging from the rim is not advised.
- 6. Do not wear any form of jewelry, as this may cause injury.
- 7. Do not use the system in severe weather.
- 8. Do not climb the pole or hang from the rim.
- 9. Check the systems before each use for loose or damaged parts.
