

- Die ersten Schleppmaschinen der DC-10 flogen erstmals am 29.08.1970. Die Interkontinentalversion Series 30 hat eine größere Spannweite und 3 General Electric Mantelstromtriebwerke mit je 25.133 kp Schub. The first production DC-10s flew for the first time on 29.8.70. The Series 30 intercontinental version had a larger wing span and 3 General Electric turbofan engines each giving 23,113 kN thrust. Cruising speed: 501 km/h at an altitude of 9,145 m; range with full payload 7,411 km. A total of 161 Series 30 DC-10s were built.
