

Function:





1. Switching on and switching off the device >II

- Long press the key ►|| for approx. 6 seconds to switch on the player. To switch it off, press the key again for approx. 3 seconds.
- Short press the key II to realize Play/Pause function when the music is playing.

2. Shuffle play

Scroll up for shuffle play, and scroll down for sequential play.

3. Fast forward ➤ and Rewind key

- Briefly press the
 → or
 ← key, to rewind or fast forward
- When playing music, press the
 or
 to skip to the previous song or next song.
- When adjusting volume, press the ➤ or ◄ to turn volume up or down.

4. Volume and Back Key 👈 📢

- Press → | ◄)) key to return to the previous interface.
- When playing music, press the □ | ◆ key to go to the Music page, press and hold the □ | ◆ key to open the volume selection menu. With the ▶ and ► keys, you can adjust the volume down and up. Because of legal provisions, you have to press the Menu key to change from level 20 to 21 to continue to increase the volume.

5. Menu Key M

When playing music, press the ${\bf M}$ key to show the playlist.

6 Music A

Music page, press $\blacktriangleright \parallel$ key to enter the music playing screen.

7. Explorer 🗎

Explorer page, press ▶II key to enter the folder list.

8. Settings \Xi

Press the ►II button to enter the menu of the settings page, press ►II key to enter the settings' sub-menus. It includes

- Display (Light Time and Brightness)

- System (About, Reset)
