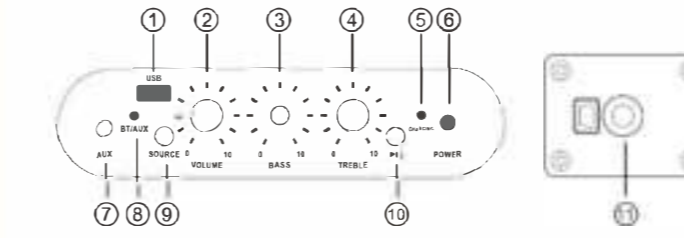

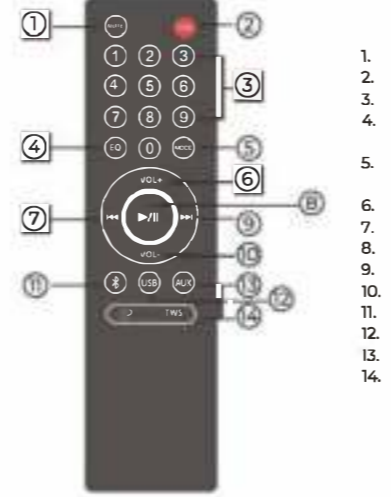

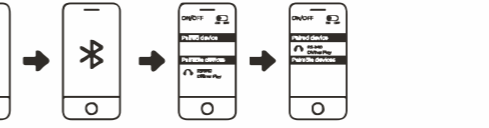

### Playback Sources

USB Playback: Insert USB into the designated port. playback will commence upon pressing play/pause button.  
 AUX Playback: Disconnect all BT devices before inserting AUX cable and connect it to audio source to start.

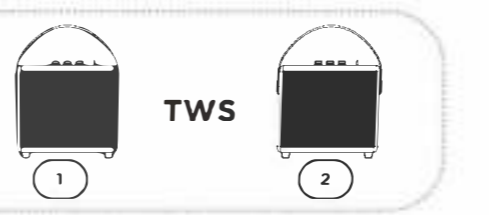
### Connecting the Product



1. Turn on Bluetooth (BT) on your mobile device.
2. Turn on the speaker.
3. Search and connect to "RS-X40 Diviner Play" from your mobile device.
4. Press and hold Play/Pause button for 3-4 seconds to disconnect.

### TWS Function

1. Turn on both speakers (Only compatible with the same model).



### Battery & Charging

#### Charging the speaker:

Connect charging adaptor to the speaker and a suitable power source.

Approximate charging time: 4-5Hours  
Please fully charge up the speaker prior to first-time usage.

### Troubleshooting

#### Unable to connect to device:

1. Please ensure the speaker is not connected to other devices
2. Please ensure the speaker is within 10m from the device

#### No sound is coming out of the speaker:

1. Please ensure your device is connected to the speaker.
2. Please ensure the music volume is at an audible level on both your mobile device and speaker.
