

## PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS FIRST BEFORE USE

### FEATURES:

HELPS TO PREVENT YOUNG CHILDREN/TODDLERS FROM OPENING, CUPBOARDS, CABINETS, APPLIANCES, TOILET SEAT, ETC... LOCKS CAN BE USED ON CURVED SURFACES AND CORNERS AND ON A VARIETY OF SURFACES INC, GLASS, METAL, WOOD AND PLASTIC. LOCKS IDEALLY SUITED TO KEEP SAFE TODDLERS UNDER TWO YEARS OF AGE.

### INSTALLATION:

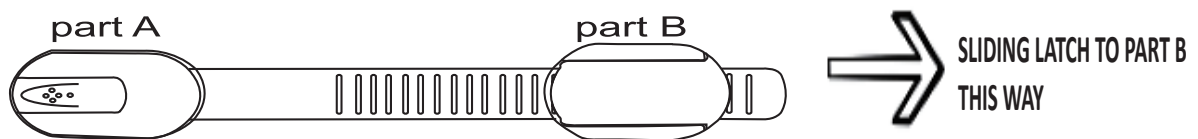
**DETERMINE INSTALLATION LOCATION.** MAKE SURE SURFACE AREA IS DRY, FREE FROM DUST, LIQUIDS OR OILY SURFACES. (Take care of removal from veneered surfaces upon discontinued use – this can be easily done by heating with a hair dryer)  
**INSTALL PART B:** PEEL OFF THE RELEASE PAPER FROM THE ADHESIVE OF PART B. FIRMLY PRESS PART B TO LOCATION FOR 2 MINS.

**WARNING! Make sure PART B is the correct way so that the Sliding Latch pushes away from PART A!**  
**Adjust the strap length and slide to lock – If at first the latch is tight to click lock, gently pull the Strap/Part A back over PART B, so that the sliding latch clicks locked.**



FOR BEST RESULTS ALLOW THE ADHESIVE TO SET FOR 2 HOURS BEFORE USE

**INSTALL PART A:** PEEL OFF THE RELEASE PAPER FROM THE ADHESIVE OF PART A. FIRMLY PRESS PART A TO LOCATION FOR 2 MINS.



**TIP:** When in the locked position, minimal strap looseness between Part A and Part B can prevent little fingers from being able to pull and tug on the strap, thereby prolonging usage.

### TO OPEN: TWO METHODS TO OPEN THE LOCK

**TO OPEN PART A:** PRESS/SLIDE CLIP BUTTON OF PART A TO OPEN THE LOCK.

**TO OPEN PART B:** PUSH AND SLIDE THE LATCH COVER OF PART B AND PULL OUT THE STRAP END TO OPEN THE LOCK

### TO CLOSE: TWO METHODS TO CLOSE THE LOCK

**TO CLOSE LOCK PART A:** PRESS THE CLIP BUTTON TO CLOSE THE LOCK.

**TO CLOSE THE LOCK PART B:** SLIDE THE STRAP END BACK INTO THE LOCK PART B AND SLIDE BACK THE LATCH COVER TO LOCK.
