## SET UP

1. Place the cooler on a flat surface.
2. Open the water tank door and fill with water(see Fig 2).
3. Insert the small head of USB cable to left back of the cooler, and another head to outer USB socket with power.

## USAGE

1. Press On/Off Button to power on the cooler.
2. Set the fan speed by pressing  button. You can choose from Low, Medium and High mode. The indicator lights next to the button show you which speed is currently running.
3. There is light color by pressing  button.
4. When you're done, press the On/Off button again to turn off the cooler.

## WARNINGS

2. The device can be switched off completely only when disconnected from the power supply.

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4. A replaceable water filter is designed specifically for this product. If your cartridge has been broken or damaged, you can purchase replacement.
5. Do not carry the cooler when filled with water. Some water may remain in unit even if tank is empty.
6. Use only clean water. If needed, use distilled water.
7. Please read and follow regular maintenance as recommended in 'Maintenance' section of this guide.
8. The cooler works best in non-polluted areas. Large dust/dirt particles may reduce lifetime of unit.
9. We recommend use only in dry locations. If using in a moist area or environment, take care not to get water on external of the product.
10. If a leak or spill occurs on the surface of device, unplug the cooler and let it dry for 24 hours. Then, use as normal.
11. Do not place in direct sunlight for extended periods of time.
12. If not using the cooler for extended periods of time, empty the water tank, turn unit on, and set to highest fan speed for at least 4 hours. This will dry out the filter and inside of your unit.
13. Only use the original USB cord supplied in package.
14. Do not touch the power supply or power cord with wet hands.
15. Unplug the cooler when cleaning, removing/replacing filter, or moving the device.
16. For best results, place the cooler on a higher surface like a table or countertop.
17. Do not place the cooler near a heater or any electrical equipment.
18. Do not place the device in passageways or high traffic areas where there is a possibility of tripping or knocking it over.
19. Do not allow any foreign objects inside the cooler.
20. Do not place items on top the cooler
21. Do not block the front and back grills of the device.
22. Do not turn the device upside and down.
23. Do not submerge the cooler under water or other liquids.
24. Do not place Arctic near open flames or fire sources.
