

USER MANUAL

DIGITAL SCALE

Thank you for choosing the KRUMBLE Digital Scale.

Let's get ready to Krumble.

FEATURES

- Weigh in G, OZ, CT, TL, DWT, OZT and GN

- TARE and counting functionality
- Display: backlit LCD

- Weight: 110g
- Pow ered by 2 AAA batteries
 Auto pow er off after 1 minute without operation

WEIGHING

 Place the scale on a flat surface and press ON/OFF key to turn on the scale, Wait until 0,0 is displayed.

- 2. Place the object in the center of the weighing platform.
- 3. Use the UNITS key to select the desired measurement unit.
- 4. Press TARE to reset the weight to 0.

CALIBRATION

- 1. Place the scale on a flat surface and press ON/OFF key to turn on the scale. Wait until 0,0 is displayed.
- 2. Press the UNITS key for 3 seconds. The screen will display "CAL". Press the UNITS key again to verify that you wish to calibrate the scale.
- 3. The required calibration weight will now be displayed. Place the required weight on the scale.
- 4. If successful, the scale display will show PASS.
- 5. Press ON/OFF to turn off the scale, the calibration is now finished.

COUNTING

- 1. Place the scale on a flat surface and press ON/OFF key to turn on the scale. Wait until 0.0 is displayed.
- 2. Place a sample amount (25, 50, 75 or 100) of the
- objects you wish to count on the platform.

 3. Press and hold the PCS key for 2 seconds until the
- number 25, 50, 75 or 100 is displayed. 4. Press the UNITS key to select the correct number of
- your sample amount.

 5. Press PCS to confirm the sample amount. PCS will
- Press PCS to confirm the sample amount. PCS will now light up on the display to show that the scale is in counting mode.
- 6. Remove the samples from platform.
- 7. Place any amount of objects you $\ensuremath{\textit{w}}$ ish to count on the scale.
- 8. Switch between weighing mode and counting mode by pressing UNITS or PCS key respectively.

REMINDER

- 1. Do not overload the scale to avoid damage to the loadcells.
- 2. Avoid exposure to extreme heat or cold. Normal room
- temperature (10 to 30 degrees Celcius) is adviced.
- 3. Place the objects you want to weigh in the center of weighing platform.
- 4. Remove the batteries when the scale will not be used for a long time.
- 5. Keep the scale in a clean environment, do not immerse the scale in water or use chemical/abrasive cleaning products.
- 6. Handle with care.
- 7. Cook and bake with love!
