<u>Tilt</u> legs

Choose from three tilt positions based on your typing preference. Sturdy legs adjust from flat to 4 or 8-degrees and hold firmly in place while you type.



LED indicators

LED lights remind you when the battery needs to be changed or Caps Lock is engaged. You can also check your keyboard battery status at any time by pressing the Battery Check key below the LED light. When the battery level is good, the LED will glow green. When it is

critical, the LED will glow red.
