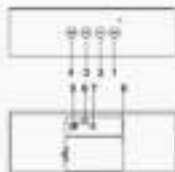

Function Instruction



1. Volume+ /Next, press & hold for Volume+, quick press for Next.
2. Play/Pause & Call function, press & hold for Bluetooth ON/OFF.
3. Volume- /Previous, press & hold for Volume-, quick press for Previous.
4. Bluetooth / FM radio /AUX IN.
5. Power switch: ON/OFF.
6. Charges via pc connection.
7. AUX IN.
8. External rechargeable battery.

Operation Instruction

1. Turn on ON/OFF to ON to start work.
2. Press "MODE" button to change between Bluetooth, FM radio, AUX IN.
Turn on first mode is BT Mode. Press "MODE" one time is FM radio, FM mode gives instant music or white noise. Press "MODE" again is Aux In, the blue light will blink quickly.
3. When it is BT mode, it gives a beep. Bluetooth function is available for device pairing. Turn on the Bluetooth function on mobile phone find the pairing name "BTS-61" after 5 seconds, there is beep heard to be connected. You can start to play music once the pairing is done.
4. In FM radio mode, press "play / pause", it will full channel automatic, push Vol+ and vol- to change preset channels afterwards (before change into FM mode you can insert the AUX cable as the outside antenna to get better signals).
5. Press Volume-/Next & Volume+/Previous at the same time, it is switch off Previous Bluetooth.

6. When Charging, the light is red, when fully charged, the red light will turn off.
