INTENDED USE

Aidapt's Disposable Bed Pads are disposable incontinence pads for men and women, designed to offer a hygienic and comfortable solution to protect beds and chairs.

With a soft facing material for comfort and a waterproof backing, Aidapt's incontinence pads are available in different sizes and absorbency rates.

Absorbency rates for incontinence pads are given as an SAP (Super Absorbent Polymers) rating; a higher rating shows a greater level of absorbency.

FITTING YOUR DISPOSABLE BED PADS Simply

place the Disposable Bed Pad onto the chair, bed or other surface, with the waterproof backing facing down. No fasteners or adhesives are required.

NB. You can place the Disposable Bed Pad directly onto the mattress and fit a sheet over it, or position it above the bed sheet, as preferred.

DISPOSAL

This product is disposable and no attempt should be made to clean and re-use it. Change the Disposable Bed Pad as often as required, this will vary depending on the user and environment. Dispose of the used Bed Pad in a plastic bag with your non-recyclable rubbish.

Aidapt mattress pads are available in different sizes and different absorption rates.

The absorption rates for pads intended for people suffering from incontinence are expressed in SAP (Super Absorbent Polymer) rates; the higher the rate, the greater the absorption capacity.

Delivered in packs of 15 or 20.

INSTALLING DISPOSABLE PADS Simply place

the disposable pad on the chair, bed or other surface you wish to protect, with the waterproof side down. No fasteners or adhesives are required.

NB: You can place the disposable mattress pad directly on the mattress then place a sheet on top or place the mattress pad on the sheet, depending on your preference.

DISPOSAL This

product is disposable. It cannot be washed or reused. Change the pad as often as necessary, this varies depending on the user and environment. Dispose of the mattress pad in a plastic trash bag with non-recyclable trash.

Absorption strengths for incontinence mats are measured in SAP (Super Absorbent Polymers); a larger value means a higher absorption strength.

ATTACHING THE PAD Simply place

the pad, waterproof side down, on a chair, bed, or other surface. Neither fastening aids nor adhesives are required.

Note: You can either place the pad on the mattress and put a sheet over it, or place it directly on the sheet, depending on your preference.

DISPOSAL This

product is intended for single use and no attempt should be made to clean and reuse the product. Change the pad as often as necessary; this depends on the user and the situation. Dispose of the pad in a plastic bag and put it in the non-recyclable trash.
