Product Description: The Owlet Cam's primary purpose is to allow the viewing and hearing of a baby. The device includes the following: a high definition camera with a wide-angle lens and firmware capable of monitoring whether or not movement is present, a microphone and firmware capable of monitoring whether or not sound is present, a speaker, a light sensor and firmware capable of adjusting the camera between infrared and normal viewing depending on the available ambient light, a power cable with an in-line temperature sensor to allow the camera to report on the room's temperature, and a power supply. The unit also includes a magnetic base (cradle) for the camera that allows the camera to be physically adjusted to face in the desired direction and at the desired angle, a wall mount and screw to allow the camera to be mounted, cable guards to protect the cable from access to a baby if the camera is mounted within approximately 1 meter of the crib, and a cable box to allow storage of any excess cable.


