
T-Rex Target Foam Ball Launcher 8 Foam Balls

O TO PLAY

- Place the T-Rex Target on a flat surface clear of other items that may get hit by the Foam Balls.
- Press the ON/OFF button and the LED screen will turn on.
- Load the Foam Balls into the Foam Ball Launcher by inserting them into the front of the gun.
- Grasp the front handle with one hand and the back handle with the other hand.
- The ball will shoot out only when it is positioned near the front of the Ammo Port. TILT THE GUN DOWNWARDS IN ORDER TO POSITION THE BALLS AT THE FRONT OF THE AMMO
- Once you are ready to shoot, straighten the gun and aim the gun towards the mouth of the T-rex.
- Create air pressure to shoot the balls by pumping the front and back handles. IT MAY TAKE A FEW PUMPS FOR THE BALL TO SHOOT OUT. DO NOT TILT THE GUN BACKWARDS. THE BALLS MAY ROLL TO THE BACK AND IT MAY BECOME VERY HARD TO SHOOT THE BALLS.
- Shoot as many balls as possible into the mouth of the T-Rex Target.
- The LED display will register the points each time a ball successfully hits the target.
- Press the ON/OFF button to turn off the LED screen.

O BATTERY INSTALLATION

- The T-Rex Target requires 2.15V "AA" batteries (not included)
- Use a Philip-head screwdriver to remove the cover to the battery compartment.
- Insert batteries according to the polarity diagram.
- Replace the cover and replace the screw.






