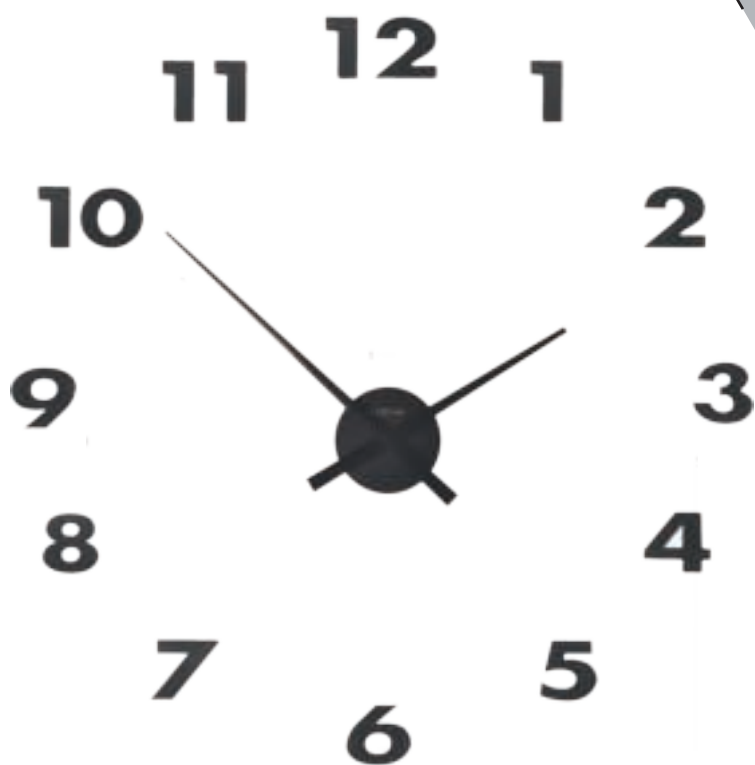


The number placer

This number placer can be used to help you to place the numbers correctly on your wall.

You can print this "number placer" on A4 paper. Then cut out the grey shape only. You can use "the number placer" now, but to make it more convenient, you can also glue your "number placer" on thicker paper or carton. Make sure to cut this into the same shape.

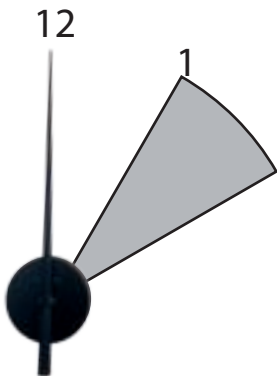


1) Hang your clock on the wall. Make sure you have minimal 27cm space available at all sides. Place the hands at the 12 o'clock position. Only turn the wheel at the backside of the movement to set the time. Never turn the hands directly.
Only turn the hands clockwise, not counterclockwise.

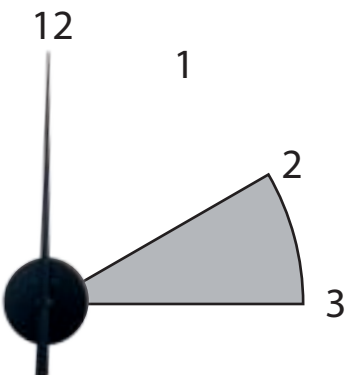


2) Place "the number placer" with the left side at 12 o'clock. The hands must align with the left side of "the number placer". Now the left side of "the number placer" is indicating the 12 o'clock position. You can place the number 12 above "the number placer". (The line is in the middle of the 1 and 2).

While the left side is still at 12 o'clock, you can also place number 1 at 1 o'clock at the right side of "the number placer". Place the number 1 in the middle of the line at the right side of "the number placer".



3) Take the number placer and move to the 1 hour. Now the left side of "the number placer" is indicating the 1 o'clock position and you can place the number 2.



4) Continue this process until all numbers are placed on your wall.
