

European Data Act – Data Usage Information (Gaming PC)

Product: Desktop Personal Computer (Gaming PC)

1. What kind of data is collected?

This product collects data about usage and its environment. Examples include:

- System performance data (CPU, GPU, memory, storage usage)
- Operating system logs and diagnostics
- Network activity while connected to the internet

File type/format: System logs and telemetry are stored in standard OS formats (text, binary, or JSON).

Approximate size: Varies depending on usage; typically less than 1 GB per year.

The device **does** collect this data continuously and **does** do so in real time while powered on.

2. Where is this data stored?

- The product **does** store data locally on the device itself.
- Some data **is** transmitted temporarily to external servers of the operating system provider for updates, diagnostics, or support.

Retention period: Local logs are typically retained for 30–90 days; data stored externally is retained according to the OS or service provider policies.

3. How can I view, share, or delete my data?

Users can manage the data collected by the device through the operating system or manufacturer's solutions, which include:

- **Accessing your data:** Via system tools such as Event Viewer, Task Manager, or telemetry dashboards
- **Requesting or sharing your data:** Through OS account settings or manufacturer software
- **Deleting your data:** Through OS privacy settings; a working delete option is available within the OS

- **Terms of service and quality of service:** Governed by the operating system provider, including availability, speed, reliability, and support
