



Quickly launch and update Lightroom and Photoshop desktop apps; manage and share assets stored in Creative Cloud; download fonts from Adobe Typekit or high-quality royalty-free assets directly within the app; and even showcase and discover creative work on Behance.










GET LIGHTROOM CC AND PHOTOSHOP CC

Click the Creative Cloud icon located in the taskbar (Windows) or Apple menu bar (Mac OS) and then click the Apps tab.



Find Lightroom CC and Photoshop CC in the list of apps and click the Install button to install the app.







DOWNLOAD MOBILE APPS FOR PHOTOGRAPHY






IMPORT PHOTOS TO LIGHTROOM

STEP 1

Open Lightroom CC on your computer. Make sure you're in the Library Module by looking in the top right corner of the app. Next, click the Import button to open the Import window.






IMPORT PHOTOS TO LIGHTROOM

STEP 2

Import photos stored on your computer, external hard drive, or camera to your library. Photos can be added to collections, just like a photo album, collections are a simple way to organise your photos. Click the 'Create Collection' button to get started. You can also sync collections to your mobile device and access and edit them using the Lightroom for Mobile app.





STEP 3

Once your photos have been imported in to Lightroom CC you can organise them into collections, edit them in the Develop module, and share them using a Lightroom Web gallery.

Make sure that syncing is turned on by clicking on your name in the top left corner of the app.


