


Set Up Your Deco

1. Download and install the Deco app



Connect your devices to the Deco's Wi-Fi to continue the setup.




8. Setup complete

Plug in the other included Deco units, and these Deco units will be automatically added to the network within 2 minutes.









Whether protecting your network from malicious attacks, managing your family's online activities, or prioritizing devices to get better performance, TP-Link HomeShield provides you a kit of basic (free) and Pro (charged) features to enhance your whole home network with enhanced security. An overview of HomeShield features are shown below.
